USED OIL & OIL FILTER FACT SHEET

USED MOTOR OIL

- When disposed of in the trash, dumped on the ground or poured down a city's storm sewer system, used oil presents an environmental hazard. For these reasons it is illegal to dispose of used oil anywhere other than at an approved oil collection site.
- Used motor oil is insoluble, persistent and contains benzene, lead and other toxic metals. Oil sticks to everything from beach sand to bird feathers. It floats on waterways. It is slow to degrade and evaporate. Just a small amount of improperly disposed motor oil can cause serious environmental damage.

HOW TO RECYCLE USED OIL

- 1) Drain your oil into a reusable, sealable container, such as a milk jug.
- 2) Don't mix other wastes with used oil. Such mixtures can create hazards and may make it impossible to recycle the oil.
- 3) Take it to a service station or auto shop that accepts used oil for recycling.
- 4) You will be directed where to deposit your oil. After you dump your oil into their container, take your reusable container home with you to use again.

MAKE YOUR EFFORTS COUNT

- ✓ Dispose of oil as you are directed to by employees at the collection site.
- ✓ Don't leave your containers of oil for someone else to find; empty them yourself or give them to the attendant.

USED OIL FILTERS

Minnesota law bans the disposal of used oil filters in the trash. A used oil filter contains about one cup of used oil. If disposed of improperly, the filters can end up polluting soil and groundwater.

SIMPLE STEPS TO RESPONSIBLE USED OIL FILTER DISPOSAL

- 1) Drain the oil filter by inverting it onto its base end and allow the oil to drain into an appropriate storage container for recycling.
- 2) Place the old filter in a leak-proof container such as a coffee can with a lid or a re-sealable plastic bag.
- 3) Bring the used oil filter (and used oil) to a service station or auto repair shop that will recycle them for you. There may be a small fee charged (\$1.00) for the oil filter.
