**A RESOLUTION DECLARING A TEMPORARY VACANCY AND APPOINTING AN
INTERIM CHIEF OF POLICE**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Le Center has been informed that a temporary vacancy exists in the office of the Chief of Police due to an unplanned leave of absence; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota law and the rules of the Board of Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST Board) require every municipality to have a designated Chief Law Enforcement Officer (CLEO) to maintain the department's licensure and operational integrity; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that an emergency appointment is necessary to ensure the continuous protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Le Center; and

WHEREAS, Kevin Huber is a licensed peace officer in good standing and possesses the leadership qualities necessary to manage the department during this transition.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LE CENTER, MINNESOTA:**

1. Kevin Huber is hereby appointed as the Interim Chief of Police for the City of Le Center, effective immediately.
2. The Interim Chief shall exercise all statutory and local authority granted to the Chief of Police, including personnel management, budgetary oversight, and state reporting requirements.
3. This appointment shall remain in effect until the return of the Chief of Police or until further action by the City Council.
4. In recognition of the significant increase in responsibility and the assumption of CLEO duties, the Interim Chief shall be compensated at the rate of \$47.52 per hour.
5. The City Administrator is directed to update the MN POST Board CLEO designation, to reflect this appointment within 48 hours.
